



Job Description for State Central Committee Member

1. State Central Committee Representative (2-year term – County Reps are elected by the delegates at their respective County Conventions, Senate Reps are elected at the State Convention by the delegates from their respective Senate District, & the Caucus and YDHI Reps are elected by their respective members at a meeting outside of the State Convention.)
 - a. Able to be a co-chair of one of the DPH's standing committees: Finance, Platform, Legislation, Rules, Affirmative Action, Membership, Fundraising, Communications, Community Relations, Convention, Campaign, and Compliance Review. The committee's responsibilities can be found in the DPH By-Laws and on the DPH website:

 - b. Automatic delegate to the State Convention.
 - c. Able to run for Party Vice Chair, Party Secretary, Party Assistant Secretary, Party Treasurer and Party Assistant Treasurer
 - d. Vote to elect Party Vice Chair, Party Secretary, Party Assistant Secretary, and Party Treasurer.
 - e. Attend all State Central Committee meetings that will take place at least every 3 months.
 - f. Fiduciary responsibility to the Party.
 - g. Senate District reps are non-voting ex officio members of the House District Council that they reside.
